CONCERN #1

The timing of the cremation is a major concern for many families we serve. One advantage of having a trusted crematory partner is that with just one phone call, your loved one's cremation can be scheduled to fit the needs of your family.

This type of express service is something for which most crematories charge extra. However, the Walker Team always goes above and beyond to meet your schedule at no additional cost to you.

On rare occasions a cremation will be delayed because of the lack of state mandated medical signatures. Should this happen we will let you know right away so you can plan accordingly.

All too often a family member receives the cremated remains and are left wondering...now what? Do you scatter the remains? Do you place them in an urn? What do you do with the urn? Sadly, failing to consider this issue creates a burden for future generations as they are faced with the task of deciding what to do with the cremated remains of family members. That is why we make it a priority to discuss the important topic with every family we serve. Fortunately, families in our area have multiple options. For example, we offer Scattering at Sea ceremonies right here in Casco Bay. In addition, some of our local cemeteries have beautiful permanent memorial options.



HONORING VETERANS

PROUDLY Serving our Veterans

Veteran Benefits

In addition to coordinating honors related to the service itself, we can help you communicate with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to arrange for:

- A Presidential Memorial Certificate: This is a certificate expressing the nation's recognition of the veteran's service. The veteran's name is inscribed, and the certificate bears the signature of the President.
- Headstones or markers: The VA provides headstones and markers for the graves of veterans anywhere in the world and for eligible dependents of veterans buried in national, state, or military cemeteries.
- **Memorial plots**: If an eligible veteran's remains are not available for burial, the VA will provide a plot and headstone or marker in a national cemetery for memorialization. If you wish to place the memorial in a cemetery other than a national cemetery, the VA will provide the headstone or marker but not the plot itself.
- Burial in a VA national cemetery or a State of Maine Veterans Cemetery: This includes the gravesite, opening and closing of the grave, and perpetual care. Maine has 4 beautiful Veterans cemeteries, two of which are in Springvale and Augusta.
- **Reimbursement of burial expenses:** For information on eligibility and the different levels of potential reimbursement, please review their Guide to VA Burial Allowances

Military Honors

Military funeral honors are free of charge and mandated by law for eligible veterans. Eligibility will be verified by the veteran's DD-214, or discharge papers. Eligible members include:

- Military members on active duty or in the Selected Reserve.
- Former military members who served on active duty and departed under honorable conditions.
- Former military members who completed at least one term of enlistment or period of initial obligated service in the Selected Reserve and departed under honorable conditions.
- Former military members discharged from the Selected Reserve due to a disability incurred or aggravated in the line of duty.

At minimum, eligible veterans are entitled to the folding and presenting of the American flag to the next of kin and the playing of Taps by a bugler or recording. These honors are performed by an honor guard detail that consists of at least two members of the Armed Forces. One member must be a representative from the branch in which the veteran served, and this member will be the individual who presents the flag.

Honors also can include:

- A three-volley rifle salute for certain veterans (eligibility varies) to represent duty, honor, and country
- The U.S. flag draped over the casket or folded properly near the urn
- A final salute at the gravesite or other location

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF \$3,695

Our charge includes consultation with the family or responsible party; staff and facilities to respond to initial requests for service; preparing and filing necessary notices, assistance with writing and submitting obituary, coordinating service plans with clergy, cemetery, crematory and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased; notifying Social Security of death; completing and filing Veterans Affairs applications; securing official documents and necessary authorizations; sheltering of the deceased for 5 days. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary however if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. It is the policy of Conroy-Tully Walker Funeral Homes to embalm if final disposition does not take place within 5 days.

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; local transfer of remains from place of death; embalming or other preparation of remains, if relevant; service vehicle to obtain all municipal permits and certificates; transportation of remains to airport (within 20 mile radius).
